<p>Stay home if you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ have cough, fever or other symptoms of illness</li> <li>✓ been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last 14 days</li> </ul> <p><i>Follow orders of the Provincial Health Officer. For more information visit:</i>  <a href="http://www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19">www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19</a></p> <p>Practice Social Distancing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Our staff are practicing social distancing and we ask our visitors to do the same.</li> <li>✓ Maintain social distancing of 6ft (2m) apart as much as possible during interactions, lining up, hiking trails, at the beach, in the marina or at the boat launch.</li> <li>✓ Limit gatherings to 8 people as recommended by public health.</li> <li>✓ When you arrive you can go directly to your site. If you need assistance, please call us from your site.</li> <li>✓ If you choose to visit us at the office, we will assist you outside within a safe distance.</li> </ul>	<p>We have enhanced our cleaning measures and ask that we all do our part to keep these areas clean.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Please use designated washroom facilities or your personal RV. When “nature calls” <u>do not</u> do your business in nature as this can be hazardous to the environment, wildlife and other campers.</li> <li>✓ Please follow occupancy limits or closure notices in common areas and accompany children while assisting them with adhering to these.</li> <li>✓ You may wish to bring along your own sanitizer or disinfectant wipes. <u>Do not</u> flush wipes as it is harmful to the septic system. Please discard them in the appropriate garbage bins.</li> <li>✓ We are providing a peroxide based cleaner in each of these facilities for your use, if you choose to clean surfaces before and after your use. <u>Do not</u> remove this cleaner and if it is running low we will happily replenish</li> <li>✓ Remember to bring flip flops for use in the showers</li> <li>✓ Practice good hand hygiene and wash often with soap and water or use an alcohol based sanitizers especially after coming in contact with a high touch surface</li> </ul>
